Those who long for the sporting life will find plenty of opportunity in Chase County. Hunters will enjoy the guiet openness of 17,000 acres of public land with walk-in access. Abundant populations of pheasant, quail, dove, turkey and deer can be found throughout the county, and the Enders Reservoir State Recreation Area is home to many species of duck as well as Canadian geese. Of added benefit are the 1500 acres of wildlife land adjoining Enders Reservoir that are open to hunters. Many of the local lodging facilities offer kennels and cleaning stations.

Enders and Champion Lake offer a variety of game fish such as Walleye, crappie, catfish and bass.



Choose from a variety of activities including wildlife and ranch tours to guided hunting expeditions (pheasant, quail, partridge, ducks, geese, Mule/Whitetail deer and coyotes).
